4.00 pm: Depart plant car park.



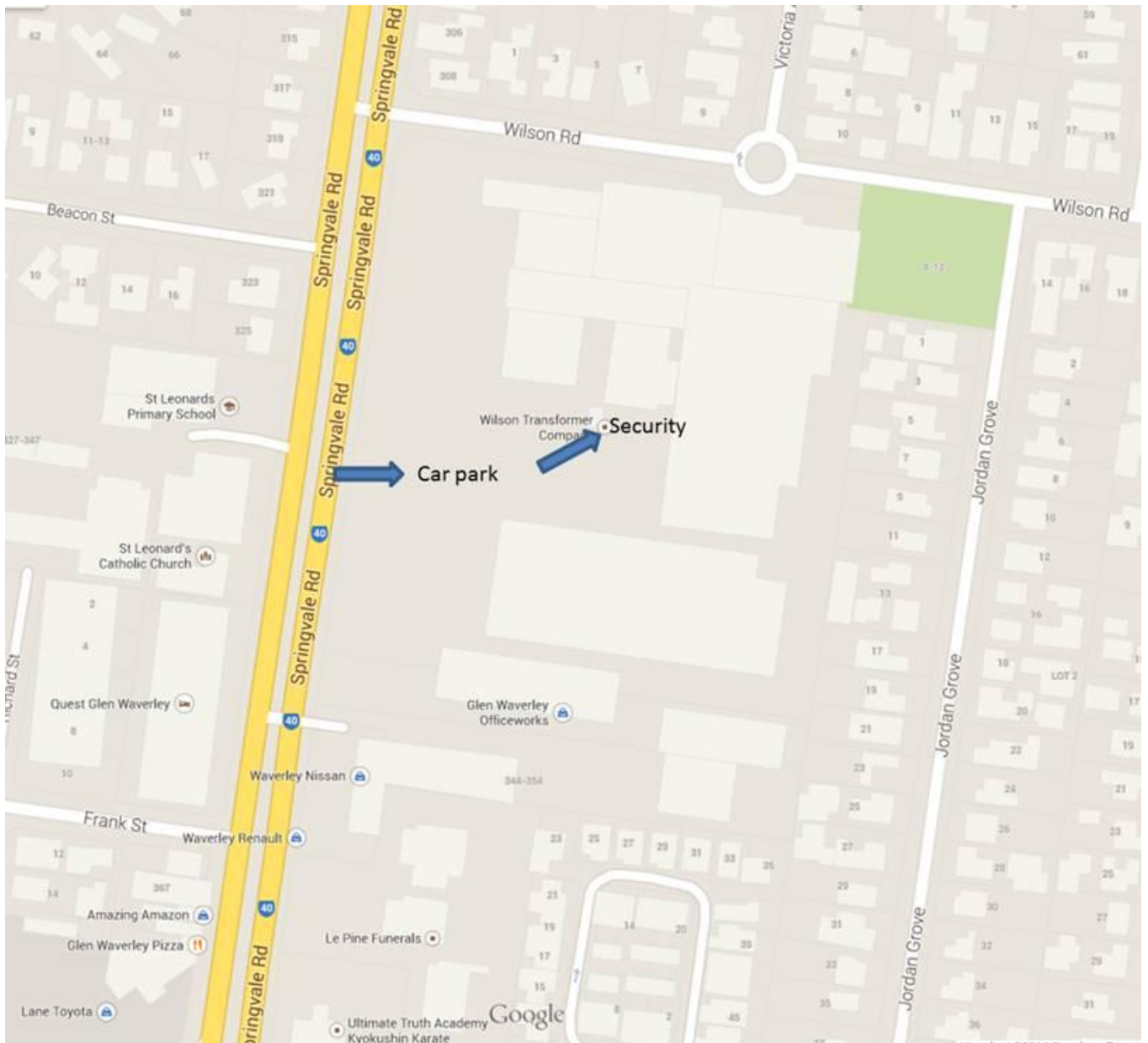
